They are currently developing scenarios, leading to portfolios, which will ultimately lead to a variety of energy resources (coal, gas, hydro, wind, solar, etc.) as well as energy efficiency and conservation programs.

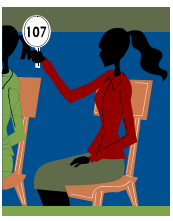
